Goodbye and Good Luck - At the end of this term we will be saying goodbye and good luck to Miss Gemma Hannis, one of the teachers in the Year R Team. End of Year Services - This year our Junior Service will be held in our Parish Church of All Hallows on **Wednesday, 19th July from 9:15 a.m. onwards**. **ALL** parents and carers have already given permission for their child to attend the services. On the morning of the service please could parents and carers take their child **directly to The Barn** (the large hall) **at All Hallows Church** for 8:45 a.m. rather than drop them off at school. The children will be walking back to school after the service, accompanied by staff and other adults.

The Nursery and Infant Service will held in school on **Tuesday, 18th July from 9:15 a.m. onwards**.
